

USEFULL INFORMATION n° 1

Circuit / Paddock / Pit garages Access:

Thursday, October, 30th from 10h00 to 20h00

Friday, October, 31st from 8h00

Outside these hours, it will be possible to park on Parking G inside the circuit.

Competitors must leave garages and paddock at the latest at 19h on Sunday and can park on Parking G until Monday morning

TRACK

The track used will be 1CV2: 5,822km with chicane.

SIGNING ON / PASSES

Competitors Office will be in VIP lodge 6, on the 1st floor of the Pit Building.

Each driver will have to sign [a waiver](#) and read the [briefings notes](#) before the testing sessions on Friday.

Supplementary passes: 15 € / week end

2 Tours d'Horloge:

In the competitors Office on Thursday from 15h00 to 20h00 and Friday, from 8h30 according to the time slot defined in your entry confirmation.

Pass: 15 passes/ car entered, given during the signing on.

ASAVE - LOTUS:

In their paddock on Thursday from 15h00 to 20h00 and Friday, from 8h30 up to 1 hour and 30 minutes before the driver's briefing.

Pass: 5 passes/ car entered, given during the signing on.

LICENCES

Drivers must have a National or International valid race licence. In case of National race licences, drivers have to hold an authorization to participate to the race from their local ASN.

Drivers can take a week-end licence for the event to do on the circuit during the signing-on. They'll must present a medical certification of less than 6 months and the driving licence.

BRIEFINGS

Driver's briefings will be in the Media Center 2, above the pit box of Paddock 2.

TECHNICAL SCRUTINEERING

Each driver must fill in the [drivers equipment form](#) and give it back to the scrutineers.

2 Tours d'Horloge: Each competitor will have to bring his car to the technical local, on Thursday from 17h00 to 20h00 and Friday, from 8h30 according to the time slot defined in your entry confirmation.

ASAVE - LOTUS: it will take place in their paddock on Friday, from 8h30 up to 1 hour and 30 minutes before the driver's briefing.

TRACK WALK

Possible by foot only on Thursday between 10h00 and 12h00 and between 18h00 and 19h00.

TRANSPONDERS

Every car has to be fitted with a Tag Heuer by Chronolec transponder for the event. Renting is possible with the timekeeper at 50 € / weekend. You can buy transponders on the ITS website, by clicking [this link](#).

PADDOCK - PIT BOX

Only trucks, trailers and racing cars are allowed in the paddock. Personal cars must be parked in the competitors' car park. All trailers will be parked in their dedicated area. The camping cars and motorhomes will be parked in the paddock.

The rental price of pit garages will be 3000 € (VAT included) for the weekend to divide by the number of cars in the garage. The pit allocation will be done by V de V Sports.

The keys will be given at the welcome office in the Pit Building, on Thursday from 10h00 à 20h00 and Friday from 8h00 to 18h00. Deposit: 50€ in cash or credit card.

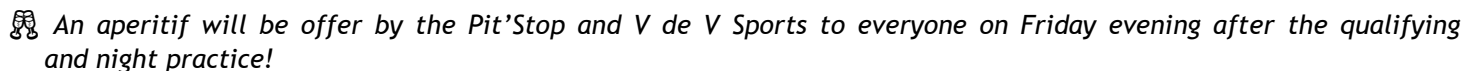
CATERING

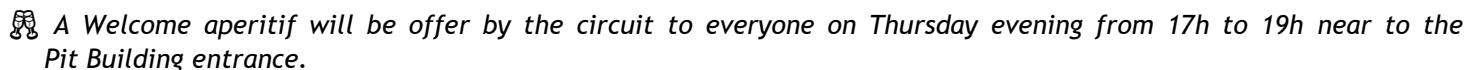
